8-Hour Food Service Sanitation Managers Certification Course Enrollment Form

The Greene County Health Department is sponsoring 8-Hour Food Service Sanitation Manager classes and exams. Classes are held at the Greene County Health Department, 310 Fifth Street, Carrollton location unless otherwise noted on the Class Schedule. Classes are taught by Liz Stemm, Greene and Calhoun County Environmental Health Inspector.

8-Hour Course (\$100) includes a self-study textbook, 8-hours of classroom review, and exam. New Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) regulations require certification candidates to attend an approved 8-hour Food Service Sanitation course. Upon successfully passing the corporate exam, IDPH will contact the registrant with an on-line application to complete and requesting the required \$36 fee for an IDPH Food Service Sanitation Certificate which is valid for 5-years (each student will actually have two different certifications). Class enrollment is limited.

Anyone wishing to enroll in a class must register and pay by the specified date at the Greene County Health Department. Payment may be made either by cash, check made payable to the *Greene County Health Department (GCHD)*, or online at <http://greenecountyhealth.com> prior to registration deadline. No enrollments will be accepted after deadline.

- Textbooks are available in the office at the time of payment. You will be responsible for reading the textbook before start of class. You should be ready to ask any questions from your reading. Class is for test review, not new information.

To Attend Class: Enrollment and payment MUST be received by the specified date to allow for class preparation. (GCHD fees do not include \$36 fee State charges for 5-year license.) **A photo ID must be presented at class** – valid Driver’s License, Secretary of State ID card, school ID card, firearm owners ID (FOID) card only if signatures and photo are shown, military ID card or a current passport are acceptable as photo identification.
