
Raising Awareness in Our Community

AFTER YOU PICK CHECK FOR TICKS

- Wear an EPA-approved insect repellent such as DEET, picaridin, or IR3535
- 2. Treat clothing with products containing permethrin and allow clothes to dry 24 hours before wearing
- 3. Tuck socks and pants in to boots.

 Wear light colored clothing so ticks can easily be seen
- 4. Remove clothing and place in hot dryer for 15 minutes after coming indoors.
- 5. Shower to remove any loose ticks and check your body for attatched ticks.
- 6. Remove ticks with tweezers, pulling up with steady pressure, don't squeeze.
- 7. Contact your doctor if you experience any of the following symptoms: fever, rash, body aches, headaches, or chills


