## BREAKING BARRIERS WITH OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDS

The Greene County Board approved the purchase of a vehicle a few months ago, using funding provided to Greene County from the Opioid Settlement Funds paid out by big Pharma for their role in the opioid epidemic. As a part of the court order, communities were to leverage funds to combat the substance use crisis. With transportation being a key barrier identified in our community needs assessment, this vehicle expands the department's capacity to help break through this barrier for the recovery community. ## DON'T FORGET SUN SAFETY

Sun safety is essential to protect your skin from harmful ultraviolet (UV) rays and reduce the risk of skin cancer, sunburn, and premature aging. Simple sun safety practices include wearing broadspectrum sunscreen with at least SPF 30, applying it generously and reapplying every two hours or after swimming or sweating. Seek shade, especially during peak sun hours between 10 AM and 4 PM, and wear protective clothing such as wide-brimmed hats, sunglasses, and long-sleeved shirts. Staying hydrated and avoiding tanning beds also contribute to overall sun safety. By incorporating these habits into your daily routine, you can enjoy the sun while keeping your skin healthy and protected. 


## MENTAL HEALTH CONTEST

































MENTAL HEALTH WINDOW PAINTING




