About the role

We are seeking a compassionate and dependable **Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)** to provide skilled nursing care to patients in their homes under the direction of a Registered Nurse and the supervision of the Home Health Manager. The Home Health LPN assists in implementing individualized care plans while promoting patient independence, safety, and quality of life.

Responsibilities

- Provides skilled nursing care within the Illinois LPN scope of practice under the direction of the Registered Nurse.
- Carries out physician orders and interventions outlined in the patient's plan of care.
- Observes, documents, and reports changes in patient condition to the supervising Registered Nurse and physician as appropriate.
- Performs treatments including wound care, medication administration, catheter care, and other skilled nursing procedures as assigned.
- Reinforces patient and caregiver education provided by the Registered Nurse.
- Maintains timely, accurate, and complete clinical documentation.
- Assists with coordination of patient care and communication among healthcare providers.
- Participates in interdisciplinary team meetings and case conferences.
- Assists with quality improvement activities and compliance initiatives.
- Maintains patient confidentiality and complies with HIPAA regulations.
- Participates in the agency's on-call rotation as assigned.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Home Health Manager or Administrator.

Candidate requirements

- Current Illinois Licensed Practical Nurse license in good standing.
- Knowledge of home health nursing principles and patient-centered care.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work independently while collaborating with an interdisciplinary healthcare team.
- Ability to perform accurate clinical documentation.
- Valid driver's license, reliable transportation, and proof of automobile insurance.
- Current CPR certification.
- Ability to work occasional evenings, weekends, and participate in an on-call rotation..
